DIAGNOSIS: MYXOMA OF SKELETAL MUSCLE.

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/65. A slowly growing lump had been present on the inner aspect of the thigh for thirteen years. The lump, together with portion of the surrounding muscle was surgically removed. There had been no recurrence after ten years.

MACROSCOPIC: Brown voluntary muscle partially surrounds a gelatinous translucent lesion. Pale yellow adipose tissue is also identifiable in the neighbourhood.

MICROSCOPIC: The tumour is a typical myxoma (upper right of field) in that it is made up of fine connective tissue fibres and widely spaced elongated and stellate cells between which is copious unstained interstitial fluid. There is a fibrous capsule with surrounding connective tissue and muscle fibres admixed with fat.
