**DIAGNOSIS:** RETROPERITONEUM - LIPOSARCOMA.

**CLINICAL HISTORY:** M/53. The patient presented with abdominal bloating and discomfort, especially while sitting. His LMO noted a large abdominal mass. At operation a retroperitoneal tumour was found, displacing the descending colon to the right and enveloping the left kidney and adrenal gland. These organs were removed along with the tumour.

**MACROSCOPIC:** The specimen consists of a multilobulated tumour measuring 30x22x12cm and weighing 4.7g. The tumour has a smooth glistening outer surface and the cut surface shows large lobules of firm pale myxoid tissue. The tumour is enclosing the kidney and adrenal gland which appear normal.

**MICROSCOPIC:** Sections of the tumour show areas of myxoid liposarcoma (left image) and areas of well differentiated sclerosing liposarcoma (right image).
