DIAGNOSIS: SUBCUTANEOUS MYXOMA (MYXOID NEUROFIBROMA).

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/39. There had been some paresthesia and numbness of the right arm “for some time” when a lump the size of an egg was discovered in the axilla. The lump was removed. It was said to be attached to a nerve.

MACROSCOPIC: The striking aspect of this ovoid lesion is its translucent appearance.

MICROSCPIC: The tumour is made up of loosely woven fine strands of connective tissue between which is copious unstained interstitial fluid. This tumour is likely to be a myxoid neurofibroma arising from a nerve sheath.
