DIAGNOSIS: RENAL TUBERCULOSIS

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/65. This man was a known long-standing sufferer of pulmonary tuberculosis. The symptoms leading to nephrectomy are not recorded.

MACROSCOPIC: Typical tuberculous cavities have destroyed much of the upper half of the kidney. Dilation of the remainder of the renal pelvis was caused by obstruction of the ureter resulting from extension of the tuberculous process.

MICROSCOPIC: The caseous tuberculous process is extending into and destroying the renal parenchyma.
