DIAGNOSIS: KIDNEY – ACUTE LEUKAEMIA

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/55. The patient presented with a two month history of increasing palpitation and pallor. Haematological investigation led to the diagnosis of acute leukaemia. Death occurred three months later. At autopsy there was massive enlargement of lymph nodes, especially the cervical and para-aortic nodes. The spleen was also enlarged (535g).

MACROSCOPIC: Specimen consists of slice of a kidney which was not enlarged, but appears pale.

MICROSCOPIC: Sections show a patchy infiltrate of the renal parenchyma by leukaemic cells.
