DIAGNOSIS: RENAL PELVIS - PHOSPHATIC CALCULUS

CLINICAL HISTORY: F/86. This elderly woman died of intracranial haemorrhage. The renal condition was found incidentally at autopsy.

MACROSCOPIC: The renal pelvis is dilated and most of the kidney parenchyma shows hydronephrotic atrophy. In the dilated pelvis there are several yellowish calculi. The largest appears to occlude the pelvi-ureteric junction and shows some evidence of branching typical of the so called staghorn calculus. Old blood has stained the upper portion of the stone.

MICROSCOPIC: No photomicrographs.
