DIAGNOSIS: RENAL PELVIS - PAPILLARY UROTHELIAL TUMOUR OF UNCERTAIN MALIGNANT POTENTIAL

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/65. The patient presented because of sudden onset of painless profuse haematuria. Following appropriate investigation nephro-ureterectomy was undertaken.

MACROSCOPIC: In the slightly dilated pelvis, there is a pale, semitransparent papillary neoplasm. The haemorrhage on the right results from the surgical procedure.

MICROSCOPIC: The tumour is made up of papillary processes covered by well differentiated transitional epithelium (urothelium). The partial separation of the cells results from poor fixation. No invasion was seen.
