DIAGNOSIS: URINARY BLADDER - CALCULUS (PROBABLY PHOSPHATIC).

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/63. Resulting from pain in the region of the hip, radiological examination demonstrated a large vesicle calculus. A subsequent IVP showed the presence of a small staghorn calculus in each renal pelvis.

MACROSCOPIC: This oval pale calculus, which weighed 160g has a slightly roughened surface and a uniform finely laminated structure on the cut face. Its size and general appearance, together with the concurrent presence of bilateral staghorn renal calculi suggest that this is probably a phosphatic stone. There is no record of relevant biochemical investigations.
