DIAGNOSIS: URINARY BLADDER - SQUAMOUS CELL CARCINOMA

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/66. This is portion of a surgical specimen resulting from partial cystectomy for carcinoma of the bladder.

MACROSCOPIC: The mucosa is ragged and haemorrhagic and the bladder wall greatly thickened. There is diffuse pale tissue disrupting the muscularis and a pale chalky area of partially cystic necrosis. At the top left is a thin walled tubular structure which is a short segment of small intestine adherent to the bladder wall. There was said to be a fistulous opening between this and the lumen of the bladder.

MICROSCOPIC: Well differentiated squamous cell carcinoma with copious keratin formation is infiltrating the muscle layer.
