**DIAGNOSIS:** BLADDER – UROTHELIAL CARCINOMA

**CLINICAL HISTORY:** M/68. The patient had preoperative irradiation but no other clinical details are available. The specimen resulted from a total cystectomy. Four years later metastases appeared in the pelvic bones and the patient died after a further 12 months.

**MACROSCOPIC:** The lower half of the bladder mucosa contains an exophytic tumour which is partly villous and partly solid.

**MICROSCOPIC:** The sections show a low grade papillary urothelial carcinoma, with thickened atypical urothelium covering the papillary structures.
