**DIAGNOSIS:** BLADDER – LOW GRADE PAPILLARY UROTHELIAL CARCINOMA

**CLINICAL HISTORY:** M/35. For the previous three years this young man had recurrent papillomas of the bladder treated by diathermy every two to three months. This had been preceded by recurrent haematuria over an interval of six years. Total cystectomy was performed.

**MACROSCOPIC:** This is the surgical specimen of bladder. Most of the normal mucosa has been replaced by redundant folds of pale papillary carcinoma. At the bottom of the specimen, this diffuse neoplastic process is seen to extend down the urethra.

**MICROSCOPIC:** The tumour consists of papillary process covered by mildly atypical urothelium, with at places than the usual seven or eight cell layers.
