DIAGNOSIS: FOREIGN BODIES IN URETHRA.

CLINICAL HISTORY: M/58. This patient, a schizophrenic, had suffered from “urinary tract infection” for a year or so. Investigations showed what was said to be a urethral calculus in the bulbourethral region. A radiograph showed foreign bodies in situ (below). Urethrotomy was performed and these foreign bodies removed. He seemed to suffer no permanent ill effects.

MACROSCOPIC: The upper concretion can be seen to encompass a piece of folded blue material and the lower to partly cover a bent intravenous needle.
