Join nurses and midwives of the Sydney Local Health District as we celebrate our research achievements in our **2019 Nursing and Midwifery Research Symposium**. We invite you to submit an abstract for presentation at the full-day symposium to be held on **Friday 15 November** in the Kerry Packer Education Centre, Royal Prince Alfred Hospital. Our theme for this year is **Voices in Harmony**.

Abstract submissions may fall into **two categories**: *Research or Practice Development*.

- We are interested in reports of both completed projects and projects in progress. Projects which have *Results* will be favoured for selection as oral presentations.
- We will provide opportunities for oral and poster presentations as well as multimedia pieces such as a video vignette.
- We will facilitate support for poster production or project filming.

Abstract submissions should be consistent with the following conference tracks. Here are some examples:

- **Clinical Practice:** Descriptions, evaluations, audits, studies or trials of clinical practice innovations, care models or approaches to care
- **Patient and family-centred care/experience:** Descriptions, explorations and studies of efforts to partner with or assess the needs or experiences of patient and family groupings
- **Workforce, workplace and systems:** Descriptions, evaluations and studies of workplace or system-based changes, re-designs or innovations
- **Technology and informatics:** Descriptions, evaluations and studies of technology and informatics innovations and initiatives
- **Incubator:** In this category, we welcome new research ideas in their infancy, which would benefit from brainstorming with peers in attendance.
