

Professor Darendeliler

Professor and Chair of Orthodontic, Discipline of Orthodontics, at the University of Sydney and Head of Department, Sydney Dental Hospital, Sydney Local Health District. He received his dentistry training from the University of Istanbul and his PhD from the University of Gazi, in Turkey and his first specialist training in orthodontics from the University of Geneva, Switzerland and his second specialist training from the High Education Council, Turkey. During the course of his career he has undertaken duties as a clinical instructor, research and postgraduate coordinator (Maître d'Assistant et de Recherche) at the University of Geneva, Assistant Professor at the University of North Carolina, Research Professor at the University of Southern California. His research interests include orthodontic tooth movement, root resorption, obstructive sleep apnoea, temporary anchorage devices, sequential aligners, self-ligating brackets, orthopaedic treatment modalities, magnetic fields and forces and dentofacial orthopaedics. He lectured in North and South America, Europe, Asia, Africa and Australia. In addition to his research and teaching commitments he also maintains a private specialist orthodontic practice.



Key Acievements:

Professor Darendeliler's students received the Elsdon Storey Award (Australian Society of Orthodontists) (ASO) (Best Research Study in Australia) six times during the last ten years, Tom Graber Award (Best Research Study award from the American Association of Orthodontists) (No other school has won this outside North America), Houston Award (Best Research Study award from the European Orthodontic Society).

Professor Darendeliler received R. Begg Award (for significant contribution to Research) (only 4 people received in the history of ASO) and Sheldon Friel Memorial Lecture Award (Highest Honour that the European Orthodontic Society can give) (FIRST AUSTRALIAN TO RECEIVE). He gave the Burston Lecture (University of Connecticut) (SECOND AUSTRALIAN TO GIVE), Vasavi Memorial Lecture (Indian Orthodontic Society) (FIRST AUSTRALIAN TO RECEIVE), Gery Dickonson Memorial Lecture (ASO), Long Service Award to the Society (ASO)
